Chair and Members:

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee, having met on October 27, 2014, makes reference to County Communication 14-249, from Councilmember Mike White, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING ON ALENUI STREET AND LANA STREET, KUAU".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit parking on both sides of Alenui Street and Lana Street ("subject roadways") in Paia, Maui, Hawaii.

At the meeting, Councilmember White transmitted a revised proposed bill, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING ON ALENUI AND LANA STREETS, KUAU", approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions.

The Director of Public Works transmitted comments from the Public Works Commission on the proposed bill. The Public Works Commission supported the proposed bill prohibiting parking on both sides of the subject roadways.

The Director informed your Committee the residents of the area requested parking be eliminated along the subject roadways because of traffic safety concerns. Vehicular traffic is restricted to one lane of travel when vehicles are parked along the subject roadways. The subject roadways are substandard and possess insufficient right-of-way widths to safely accommodate two lanes of vehicular traffic and parking.

The Director stated the use of Lana Street for parking by visitors of the Sunset Catholic Cemetery should be evaluated. The Director recommended placing a time restriction on parking as a method for mitigating parking concerns while accommodating the needs of cemetery visitors.

Your Committee notes a member of your Committee inspected the site and determined, in consultation with the community, that sufficient off-street parking is available for visitors of the Sunset Catholic Cemetery.

The Director further stated signs will be installed to identify the parking restriction upon passage of the proposed bill.

Your Committee noted several testifiers, who identified themselves as residents of the area, expressed a desire to expand the parking prohibition to include Aleiki Place and Kaimao Street located adjacent to the subject roadways.

Your Committee further noted the concern that eliminating parking on the subject roadways may exacerbate parking problems along the other substandard streets within the area.

Your Committee notes a member of your Committee indicated they would explore a parking prohibition on Aleiki Place and Kaimao Street.

Your Committee voted 5-0 to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Cochran, Vice-Chair Crivello, and members Couch, Guzman, and White voted "aye". Committee members Carroll and Hokama were excused.

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

1. That Bill _____ (2014), as revised herein and attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING ON ALENUI AND LANA STREETS, KUAU", be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT; and
2. That County Communication 14-249 be FILED.

BILL NO. _____ (2014)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040,
MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING,
STANDING, AND PARKING ON ALENUI AND LANA STREETS, KUAU

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 10.48.040, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection C to read as follows:

“C. Makawao District.

1. On the north side of Makawao Avenue from the intersection of Makawao Avenue and Baldwin Avenue to a point one hundred fifty feet west of the intersection at Makawao;

2. On the west side of Baldwin Avenue, Paia, from the entrance to Paia Mill warehouse for a distance of two hundred feet in the direction of Makawao;

3. On the mauka side of Hana Highway in Pauwela, between Haiku School Road and West Kuiaha Road;

4. On the south side of Makawao in Makawao from the intersection of Makawao Avenue and Baldwin Avenue to a point seventy feet west of the intersection applicable only on school days from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.;

5. On the north side of Haliimaile Road for a distance of approximately thirty feet from the Haleakala Junction;

6. On both sides of Kilakila Place in Pukalani, within three hundred feet of its intersection with Haleakala Highway;

7. On both sides of Kokomo Road, between Haiku Road and Lowrie Ditch;

8. On both sides of Ulumau Place[.];

9. On both sides of Alenui Street;

10. On both sides of Lana Street.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
