#### **AMENDING THE ACQUISITION AND DISPOSITION REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO INFRASTRUCTURE-RELATED PROPERTY (IEM-60)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 13-34, from Councilmember Michael P. Victorino, transmitting a proposed bill relating to the conveyance of road-widening lots and related easements.
2. County Communication 14-187, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill relating to the conveyance, exchange, and appraisal requirements pertaining to infrastructure-related property.
4. Correspondence dated February 23, 2015, from Committee Chair Elle Cochran, to the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ACQUISITION, EXCHANGE AND APPRAISAL REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO INFRASTRUCTURE-RELATED PROPERTY". The purpose of the proposed bill is to improve the County's infrastructure by granting the Administration greater authority to acquire real property and easements.

**DEDICATION OF EHA STREET (WAILUKU) (IEM-59)**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 13-28, from Councilmember Michael P. Victorino, transmitting the matter relating to the dedication of a portion of Eha Street for use as a public roadway.
2. Correspondence dated February 10, 2015, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting the following:
  - a. A proposed resolution entitled “ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF A ROADWAY LOT FOR THE EHA STREET EXTENSION SUBDIVISION PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE”. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept Lot 10, consisting of 2.910 acres, containing the portion of Eha Street located makai of the Wailuku Post Office and mauka of the Velma McWayne Santos Community Center, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii.
  - b. A proposed resolution entitled “ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS FOR THE IAO PARKSIDE SUBDIVISION PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE”. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept Lot 8 (2.835 acres) and Lot 9 (0.030 acre) containing the portion of Eha Street located makai of the Velma McWayne Santos Community Center and mauka of Alua Street; and Lot 35 (29,012 square feet) containing the portion of Waena Street adjacent to the Velma McWayne Santos Community Center, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii.
