UPCOUNTRY WATER METER INSTALLATION (WR-28)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 15-174, from Councilmember Gladys C. Baisa, relating to amending Section 14.13.060, Maui County Code, relating to Upcountry water meter installation.
2. Correspondence dated July 29, 2015, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill to provide that applicants on the Upcountry priority list offered water meters from the Department of Water Supply and who are able to connect to the Department's existing water system shall not be required to make further infrastructure mainline improvements for fire protection under certain conditions.
3. Correspondence dated August 26, 2015, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14.13 AND SECTION 18.20.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WATER METER ISSUANCE PROVISIONS FOR THE UPCOUNTRY WATER SYSTEM." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to provide that applicants on the Upcountry priority list offered water meters from the Department of Water Supply and who are able to connect to the Department's existing water system shall not be required to make further infrastructure mainline improvements for fire protection or improvements to existing streets under certain conditions.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 15-174 and other related action.
