MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE (2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE) (PIA-4(1))

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 15-158, from Presiding Officer Pro Tempore, relating to matters pertaining to the Maui County Legislative Package.
2. Correspondence dated September 17, 2015, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL PROHIBITING SMOKING IN MOTOR VEHICLES OCCUPIED BY MINORS." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize for inclusion in the 2016 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SMOKING." The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit smoking in vehicles occupied by minors.
3. Correspondence dated September 18, 2015, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM WAGE TO \$15.00 PER HOUR IN 2019." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize for inclusion in the 2016 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to provide that every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the employer wages at the rate of not less than \$15.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2019.

Correspondence dated September 21, 2015, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL TO ALLOW PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES TO INDICATE ON THEIR IDENTIFICATION CARDS THEIR DISABILITY." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize for inclusion in

the 2016 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.” The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow persons with disabilities to indicate on their identification cards their disability.

Correspondence dated September 21, 2015, from Councilmember Robert Carroll, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL THAT PROHIBITS THE SALE OF MARINE LIFE SECURED BY A SPEAR.” The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize for inclusion in the 2016 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO AQUATIC RESOURCES.” The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit the sale of marine life secured by use of a spear.
6. Correspondence dated September 25, 2015, from Councilmember Gladys C. Baisa, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2016 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL AUTHORIZING COUNTY LIQUOR COMMISSIONS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR ALCOHOL ABUSE TREATMENT AND PREVENTION.” The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize for inclusion in the 2016 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.” The purpose of the proposed bill is require county liquor commissions to provide funding for alcohol abuse treatment and prevention, in addition to education and enforcement, within their counties.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolutions, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action.
