DONATION OF A SCENT-TRACKING DOG TO THE DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (PIA-59)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 15-279, from the Chief of Police, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A DONATION OF A SCENT TRACKING DOG TO THE COUNTY OF MAUI POLICE DEPARTMENT, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the acceptance of a scent-tracking dog, valued at \$5,000, from Friends of the Missing Child Center-Hawaii, to the Department of Police.
