#### **INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS FOR VARIOUS WATER PROJECTS (DRINKING WATER TREATMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND) (BF-59)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 15-259, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4128, BILL NO. 32 (2014), AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS FOR LOANS FROM THE STATE OF HAWAII'S DRINKING WATER TREATMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND FOR VARIOUS WATER PROJECTS, FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET ORDINANCE." The purpose of the proposed bill is to reallocate funding from the Lahainaluna Road Booster – Phase I project to the Omaopio 2.1 MG Replacement and the Wailuku Heights Tank 30 Booster projects.
