Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on November 23, 2015, makes reference to County Communication 15-164, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to amendments to the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016 Budget.

By correspondence dated October 19, 2015, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, HIGHWAYS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND, ROAD, BRIDGE, AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND, TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2016 Budget by (1) increasing the appropriation to the Department of Public Works, Highways Administration Program – Highway Fund, by \$2,000, from \$523,768 to \$525,768; (2) increasing the appropriation to the Department of Public Works, Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Program – Highway Fund, by \$55,000, from \$10,679,515 to \$10,734,515; and (3) decreasing the appropriation to the Department of Public Works, Traffic Management Program – Highway Fund, by \$57,000, from \$1,536,547 to \$1,479,547. The funds will be used for projected premium pay shortfalls in the identified programs.

The Budget Director said the Administration had chosen to transmit a proposed bill to accomplish this transfer because the transfer is between categories and between programs. He said the proposed bill will primarily cover overtime costs the Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Program incurred during hurricane warning pre-mitigation efforts.

Your Committee noted testimony relating to maintenance of an access road into Keanae, Maui, and concerns of rocks falling from the adjacent hillside on a weekly basis. Your Committee questioned ownership and maintenance responsibilities for property abutting Keanae Road and the status of the Keanae Road Safety Improvements project and related engineering study. Your Committee directed an inquiry be sent to the Director of Public Works for response.

Your Committee voted 5-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Hokama and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, and Crivello voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair White and members Couch, Guzman, and Victorino were excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS that Bill ______ (2015), attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, HIGHWAYS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND, ROAD, BRIDGE, AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND, TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT.
