Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on November 23, 2015, makes reference to County Communication 15-164, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to amendments to the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016 Budget.

By correspondence dated October 9, 2015, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET."

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to transfer, from Category B (operations or services) to Category C (equipment), the following appropriations within the Department of Fire and Public Safety for equipment purchases: \$6,391 within the Administration/Maintenance Program, \$9,608 within the Training Program, \$8,655 within the Fire/Rescue Operations Program, and \$1,159 within the Fire Prevention Program. The transfers are intended to appropriately account for the use of funds appropriated in the FY 2016 Budget.

At the request of the Chair of your Committee, the Budget Director transmitted a revised proposed resolution, entitled "AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET," approved as to form and legality. The revised proposed resolution incorporates nonsubstantive revisions and references to Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in the FY 2016 Budget, which restricts disbursements for each program by category of use, with allocations specified for: (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay (Category A); (b) operations or services (Category B); and (c) equipment (Category C).

Section 7 authorizes any transfer from one program to another or one category of use to another by resolution, and any transfer from one department to another by ordinance.

The Budget Director said the transfer within the Administration/Maintenance Program is for the lease of a copier and the purchase of laptops and software. The transfer within the Training Program is for two automatic external defibrillators (first-aid devices used to restore normal heart rhythm). The transfer within the Fire/Rescue Operations Program is for firefighting equipment—specifically, a power saw and a monitor package (for unmanned use at a fire, allowing the nozzle to get close to the fire while being operated remotely). Finally, the transfer within the Fire Prevention Program is for a self-supporting frameless water tank.

Your Committee voted 5-0 to recommend adoption of the revised proposed resolution. Committee Chair Hokama and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, and Crivello voted “aye.” Committee Vice-Chair White and members Couch, Guzman, and Victorino were excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS that Resolution \_\_\_\_\_, attached hereto, entitled “AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET,” be ADOPTED.

AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED  
APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE  
DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY,  
FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 9-10(2) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), provides that, upon written request of the Mayor, part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance may be transferred within a department by resolution or from one department to another by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in Ordinance No. 4231, Bill No. 38 (2015), Draft 1, as amended, ("Fiscal Year 2016 Budget"), states that, unless otherwise provided, appropriations for each program may be disbursed for the following categories of use: (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay, (b) operations or services, and (c) equipment; provided the disbursement is within the program and category of use for which it was appropriated, as set forth in Appendix C; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions further provides that any transfer from one program to another or one category of use to another shall be authorized by Council resolution, and any transfer from one department to another shall be authorized by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B.5. of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget, relating to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, sets forth appropriations for the Administration/Maintenance Program; Training Program; Fire/Rescue Operations Program; and Fire Prevention Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter and Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions, Mayor Alan M. Arakawa has submitted a written request to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$6,391 from the Administration/Maintenance Program, Category B, to the Administration/Maintenance Program, Category C; \$9,608 from the Training Program, Category B, to the Training Program, Category C; \$8,655 from the Fire/Rescue Operations Program, Category B, to the Fire/Rescue Operations Program, Category C; and \$1,159 from the Fire Prevention Program, Category B, to the Fire Prevention Program, Category C, in order to disburse \$25,813 for equipment from the appropriate category; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:



That, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter and Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions, and in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget, it does hereby authorize the transfer of an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$6,391 from the Administration/Maintenance Program, Category B, to the
