#### **ELIMINATING BUILDING CODE EXEMPTIONS FOR CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS (IEM-09)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 13-135, dated April 11, 2013, from Councilmember Mike White, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.26B.101, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ELIMINATE EXEMPTIONS IN THE BUILDING CODE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI RELATING TO LANDS WITHIN THE CONSERVATION DISTRICT OR LANDS DESIGNATED AS HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS." The purpose of the proposed bill is to eliminate Building Code exemptions for real property within the Conservation District or real property designated as Hawaiian Home Lands.

**STATUS:** The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage on first reading of the proposed bill, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 13-135 and other related action.

**INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE (IEM-53)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of a Miscellaneous Communication, dated May 28, 2014, from the Deputy County Clerk, transmitting the matter relating to the County's information technology infrastructure, including updates from the Management Information Systems program and development of the County's computer security preparedness plan.
