MAUI METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (HHT-29)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 15-294, from the Director of Transportation, transmitting the following:
 - a. A proposed bill to establish the Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization in Title 2 of the Maui County Code, to meet the requirements of Federal law for Federal funding for transportation planning.
 - b. A proposed bill to authorize the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Hawaii to establish the Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization to enable the County to receive Federal funding for transportation planning and carry out coordinated and integrated metropolitan transportation planning, in accordance with 23 United States Code sections 134 and 135, and Chapter 279D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
2. Correspondence dated January 19, 2016, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting the following:
 - a. A revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH THE MAUI METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to amend Title 2, Maui County Code, to establish the Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization.
 - b. A revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF HAWAII TO FULFILL FEDERAL AND STATE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE MAUI METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement, in the form attached as Exhibit "A" to the revised proposed bill, relating to the Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization.
