**DESCRIPTION:**

Correspondence dated December 7, 2015, to the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.80B.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ADOPT THE UPDATED LANAI COMMUNITY PLAN." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to adopt the decennial revisions to the Lanai Community Plan, pursuant to Section 2.80B.090, Maui County Code. **DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 14-310, from Councilmember Elle K. Cochran, transmitting a proposed bill to allow for composting as a permitted use in the County Agricultural District.
2. Correspondence dated September 18, 2015, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “REFERRING TO THE LANAI, MAUI, AND MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSIONS A PROPOSED BILL AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO COMPOSTING.” The purpose of the proposed resolution is to refer to the planning commissions a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO COMPOSTING.” The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow for composting using materials sourced from off-site as a permitted use in the County Agricultural District.
