Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 28, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 15-164, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to amendments to the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016 Budget.

By correspondence dated March 10, 2016, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (PAUL COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCES IMPROVEMENT ACT)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the FY 2016 Budget by adding \$7,410 for the Department of Police, for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act grant, to purchase three portable gunshot residue and explosives detection systems - one for Lanai, Maui, and Molokai.

A representative of the Department of Police explained there is a four-hour window after a gun is fired to recover evidence from the hands of the person who fired it. The portable gunshot residue and explosives detection systems would help the Department recover time-sensitive evidence within that timeframe.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Baisa, Carroll, Couch, Crivello, and Victorino voted "aye." Committee members Cochran and Guzman were excused.



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE -
SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE
(PAUL COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCES IMPROVEMENT ACT)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4231, Bill No. 38 (2015), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2016 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2016, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Police, by adding a new grant entitled, "Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act", in the amount of \$7,410 to read as follows:
