#### **ELIMINATING BUILDING CODE EXEMPTIONS FOR CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS (IEM-9)**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 13-135, from Councilmember Mike White, transmitting a proposed bill to eliminate exemptions in the Building Code of the County of Maui relating to lands within the Conservation District or lands designated as Hawaiian Home Lands.
2. Correspondence dated July 5, 2016, to the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.26B.101, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ELIMINATE THE EXEMPTION IN THE BUILDING CODE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI RELATING TO LANDS WITHIN THE CONSERVATION DISTRICT." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to eliminate the exemption in the Building Code of the County of Maui relating to lands within the Conservation District.

**STATUS:**

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 13-135 and other related action.

#### **AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042, MAUI COUNTY CODE, CROSSWALKS ESTABLISHED, WAILUKU DISTRICT (IEM-58)**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-115, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO

CROSSWALKS.” The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a crosswalk on Lower Main Street approximately 400 feet north of its intersection with Mill Street.
