AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING (WAILUKU) (IEM-69)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-148, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING." The purpose of the proposed bill is to delete from the list of streets where parking is prohibited in the Wailuku District, Pili Street between Market Street and Church Street, since Pili Street has been consolidated into the Wailuku Municipal Parking Lot parcel.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 16-148 and other related action.
