CONDITION OF GROUNDWATER SOURCE AT IAO TUNNEL, IAO SURFACE WATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND OTHER FACILITIES (WR-6(5))

2. Na Wai Eha case relating to Interim Instream Flow Standards (CCH-MA06-01).
3. East Maui case relating to Interim Instream Flow Standards (CCH-MA13-01).

STATUS: The Committee may receive an update on the contested cases pending before the Commission on Water Resource Management.

NOTE: With reference to this agenda item, one or more executive meetings are anticipated pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to consult with legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of the County, the Council, and the Committee.
