Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on November 29, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-292, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS (KAISER FOUNDATION HEALTH PLAN).”

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by adding a new grant for the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, entitled “Kaiser Foundation Health Plan,” in the amount of \$7,500. The funds supported the 15th Annual Maui Family Caregivers Conference.

Your Committee notes there were two keynote speakers at the Conference: (1) Jeanette C. Takamura, Ph.D., who was instrumental in advocating family caregiver funding in the Older Americans Act; and (2) Michael Cheang, Ph.D., whose research interests include transference of family values to children with respect to family resource management, family caregiving, volunteerism, and intergenerational projects. The Conference also featured special presentations by Dr. Laurel Coleman, a geriatric physician; and Patricia Bemis, a registered nurse and caregiver.

The Director of Housing and Human Concerns said the Conference was held on November 18, 2016, with over 350 attendees.

A representative from the Department of Housing and Human Concerns said the Kaiser Foundation helped to sponsor the event.
