Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on November 1, 2016, and November 29, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-230, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, 2154 KAOHU STREET BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by adding an appropriation of \$185,000 for building renovations at 2154 Kaohu Street, Wailuku, Hawaii.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, 2154 KAOHU STREET BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding \$185,000 under the Department of Public Works,

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2017, dated September 30, 2016, for \$185,000 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.

By correspondence dated November 17, 2016, the Budget Director, transmitted the following:

1. A revised proposed bill to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by (1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$50,000; and (2) adding an appropriation of \$50,000 under the Department of Public Works, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, General Fund, for 2154 Kaohu Street Building Improvements.
2. A revised proposed bill to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding: (1) an appropriation of \$50,000 under the Department of Public Works, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, for 2154 Kaohu Street Building Improvements; and (2) a description of the project.

Your Committee noted future Kalana O Maui campus expansion plans include construction of parking on the project property and possible demolition of buildings on the property.

Your Committee expressed concern about authorizing \$185,000 for improvements to a building that may be demolished in the near future. To address your Committee's concerns, the Department reduced the budget amendment request from \$185,000 to \$50,000. The Budget Director informed your Committee the \$50,000 will be used for air conditioning, electrical improvements, and related permitting costs for one of the buildings on the property.

The Mayor said the building will be occupied by the Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization (Maui MPO), Community Development Block Grant staff, and one Executive Assistant from the Office of the Mayor.

The Director of Public Works informed your Committee the Maui MPO does not have funds available for capital improvements or rent. However, the County can request in lieu contributions by calculating the potential rent and common area maintenance fees it could charge the Maui MPO and utilize that amount as part of the County's match to leverage Federal funds.

Your Committee voted 5-0 to recommend passage of the revised proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, and Couch voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair White and members Crivello, Guzman and Victorino were excused.
