Correspondence dated February 6, 2017, to the Department of the Corporation Counsel transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.44.050, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPS REQUIRED AT NON-THROUGH STREET INTERSECTIONS AT MEHA ROAD AND KEALALOA AVENUE, MAKAWAO, MAUI, HAWAII." The purpose of the proposed bill is to delete the stop requirement on Meha Road, before entering Kealaloa Avenue in Makawao.
