**In the matter of the accusation against MAUI'S FRESH TAMALES AND MEXICAN RESTAURANT dba THE DOG & DUCK IRISH PUB, Dispenser General License No. 159, 1913-N South Kihei Road, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On December 9, 2016 at approximately 10:00 p.m., MAUI'S FRESH TAMALES AND MEXICAN RESTAURANT dba THE DOG & DUCK IRISH PUB, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

Count 2. On December 9, 2016 at approximately 10:00 p.m., MAUI'S FRESH TAMALES AND MEXICAN RESTAURANT dba THE DOG & DUCK IRISH PUB, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), fail to properly check the identification of a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 08-101-61(c) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2017-22, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against VILLAGE TAVERN, LLC dba TAVERNA, Dispenser General License No. 020, 2000 Village Road, Kapalua, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On January 15, 2017 at approximately 7:56 p.m., VILLAGE TAVERN, LLC dba TAVERNA, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor

Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

- Count 2. On January 15, 2017 at approximately 7:56 p.m., VILLAGE TAVERN, LLC dba TAVERNA, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), fail to properly check the identification of a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 08-101-61(c) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2017-23, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against GALA INC. dba SOUTH SHORE TIKI LOUNGE, Restaurant General License No. 434, 1913 South Kihei Road, Suite J, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.**

- Count 1. On January 22, 2017 at approximately 7:30 p.m., GALA INC. dba SOUTH SHORE TIKI LOUNGE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

- Count 2. On January 22, 2017 at approximately 7:30 p.m., GALA INC. dba SOUTH SHORE TIKI LOUNGE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), fail to properly check the identification of a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 08-101-61(c) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
