AMENDING CHAPTER 14.06A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WATER SHORTAGE DECLARATIONS (WR-12)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-243, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14.06A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WATER SHORTAGE DECLARATIONS." The purposes of the proposed bill are to amend notification and publication requirements for declarations of water shortage, and to shorten the period within which agricultural consumers are required to implement restrictions or mandates imposed by water shortage declarations from 90 to 30 days following publication.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 17-243 and other related action.
