### NOMINATIONS TO BOARDS, COMMITTEES, AND COMMISSIONS (MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSION) (PEA-2(14))

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated July 7, 2017, from the Mayor, transmitting a proposed resolution, entitled "RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF LAAKEA POEPOE TO THE MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSION," along with a completed application form for the nominee.
