DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES (PEA-39)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 17-295, from Councilmember Stacy Crivello, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "URGING THE MAYOR TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to urge the Mayor to provide for an additional deferred compensation plan for County employees, allowing for an alternative fixed annuity option to save for retirement on a tax-deferred basis.
2. Correspondence dated September 7, 2017, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TERMINATE THE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF HAWAII ISLAND SAVINGS PLAN AND PROCURE FOR A DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to urge the Mayor to terminate the agreement with the State of Hawaii Island Savings Plan and procure for a new deferred compensation plan for the County of Maui through the appropriate request for proposals process.

PROHIBITING SMOKING IN VEHICLES WHEN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN ARE PRESENT (PEA-41)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-319, from Councilmember Yuki Lei K. Sugimura, transmitting a proposed bill, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8.20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN VEHICLES WHEN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN ARE PRESENT." The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit smoking in vehicles when minors under eighteen years of age are present, thus reducing exposure to second-hand smoke.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 17-319 and other related action.

MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE (2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE) (PEA-4(1))

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 17-9, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to matters pertaining to the Maui County Legislative Package.
2. Correspondence dated September 8, 2017, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting the following:
 - a. A proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL RELATING TO ENFORCEMENT OF THE BASIC BILL OF RIGHTS FOR VICTIMS AND WITNESSES." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve for inclusion in the Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill, attached to the proposed resolution as Exhibit "A," entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VICTIM RIGHTS." The purpose of the proposed State bill is to allow for more stringent enforcement of the Basic Bill of Rights for Victims and Witnesses by holding implementing parties accountable.
 - b. A proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL PROHIBITING THE SALE OF SKIN CARE PRODUCTS CONTAINING OXYBENZONE AND OCTINOXATE." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve for inclusion in the Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill, attached to the

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proposed resolution as Exhibit "A," entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO OXYBENZONE AND OCTINOXATE." The purpose of the proposed State bill is to prohibit the sale of skin care products containing Oxybenzone and Octinoxate.

- c. A proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL TO INCREASE REVENUE FOR EACH COUNTY'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND THROUGH AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT CONVEYANCE TAX ON PROPERTIES VALUED AT MORE THAN \$2 MILLION." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve for inclusion in the Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill, attached to the proposed resolution as Exhibit "A," entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE CONVEYANCE TAX." The purpose of the proposed State bill is to increase revenue for each county's affordable housing fund through an additional one percent conveyance tax on the sale of condominium or single-family residential properties with a value of more than \$2 million.
- d. A proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL TO INCREASE THE STATE MINIMUM WAGE TO \$15.00 PER HOUR FOR EMPLOYERS WITH 26 EMPLOYEES OR MORE BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND FOR EMPLOYERS WITH 25 EMPLOYEES OR LESS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve for inclusion in the Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill, attached to the proposed resolution as Exhibit "A," entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE." The purpose of the proposed State bill is to raise the State minimum wage to \$15.00 per hour through a 5-step graduated scale for employers with 25 employees or less, and a 3-step graduated scale for employers with 26 employees or more, with the first steps beginning on January 1, 2019.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolutions, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
