Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 17-9, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to matters pertaining to the Maui County Legislative Package.
2. Correspondence dated September 8, 2017, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2018 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL RELATING TO ENFORCEMENT OF THE BASIC BILL OF RIGHTS FOR VICTIMS AND WITNESSES." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve for inclusion in the 2018 Maui County Legislative Package a proposed State bill, attached to the proposed resolution as Exhibit "A," entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VICTIM RIGHTS." The purpose of the proposed State bill is to allow for more stringent enforcement of the Basic Bill of Rights for Victims and Witnesses by holding implementing parties accountable.

ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADS APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR (PEA-27)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 17-134, from Councilmember Yuki Lei K. Sugimura, relating to the matter of establishing additional qualifications for County department directors.
2. Correspondence dated October 10, 2017, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to amend the Maui County Code by adding a new chapter to establish additional specific qualifications for the director of public works and the director of environmental management, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 6-4, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 17-134 and other related action.
