PROHIBITING SMOKING IN VEHICLES WHEN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN ARE PRESENT (PEA-41)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-319, from Councilmember Yuki Lei K. Sugimura, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8.20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN VEHICLES WHEN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN ARE PRESENT." The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit smoking in vehicles when minors under eighteen years of age are present, thus reducing their exposure to second-hand smoke.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 17-319 and other related action.
