#### AMENDING SECTION 10.48.250, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS PARKING (PRL-38)

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-479, from Council Chair Mike White, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.250, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS PARKING." The purpose of the proposed bill is to specify times when parking is permitted in public beach access parking areas, which include County-owned and privately-owned parking areas.
