#### REIMBURSEMENT FOR SUBDIVISION WATER MAIN **EXTENSION** (WR-11)

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-242, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.05.050, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR SUBDIVISION WATER MAIN EXTENSION." The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish maximum reimbursement amounts for subdivision water main extensions. The proposed bill also defines the term "large quantities of water" as it applies to the conditions under which reimbursement for off-site water mains may be approved.

**Status:** The Committee may discuss the proposed bill. No legislative action will be taken.
