SAND MINING OF CENTRAL MAUI INLAND SAND (IEM-33)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 18-51, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed bill to amend Section 2.40.020, Maui County Code, relating to the definition of sand mining.
2. A Miscellaneous Communication, dated April 20, 2018, from the County Clerk, reporting that the Council referred Contract C6477 with SSFM International, Inc., for the Maui Inland Sand Resource Quantification Study Update for the Department of Public Works.
3. Correspondence dated July 10, 2018, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 20.40A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, DECLARING A CONTINUED MORATORIUM ON SAND MINING OF CENTRAL MAUI INLAND SAND." The purpose of the proposed bill is to: 1) enact a continued moratorium on sand mining of central Maui inland sand until the Council determines the purposes established in the proposed bill have been satisfied, or December 31, 2018, whichever is sooner; and 2) allow the Council, by resolution, to extend the term of the moratorium on sand mining of central Maui inland sand prior to the repeal of the ordinance.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill noted in paragraph 3 on first reading, with or without
