MOLOKA`I COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE (PC-2)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 16-98, from the Planning Director, transmitting the following:
 - a. A proposed bill amending Section 2.80B.070, Maui County Code, to adopt the decennial revisions to the Moloka`i Community Plan.

The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to adopt the decennial revisions to the Moloka`i Island Community Plan, pursuant to Section 2.80B.090, Maui County Code. The revised proposed bill's Exhibit "1" is the proposed updated Moloka`i Island Community Plan (2018), incorporating revisions recommended by the Committee.
