MOLOKA'I COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE (PC-2)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to adopt the decennial revisions to the Moloka'i Island Community Plan, pursuant to Section 2.80B.090, Maui County Code. proposed bill's Exhibit "1" is the proposed updated Moloka'i Island Community Plan (2018), incorporating revisions recommended by the Committee.
