AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF THE REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 95 OHANA HANA LOOP TO HOUSING AND LAND ENTERPRISE OF MAUI DBA NA HALE O MAUI (WAILUKU) (HHT-51)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 18-312, from the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF THE REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 95 OHANA HANA LOOP, WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII, TO HOUSING AND LAND ENTERPRISE OF MAUI DBA NA HALE O MAUI." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to grant the County-owned property identified for real property tax purposes as tax map keys (2) 3-5-036:046 and a fifty percent interest in (2) 3-5-036:057, a shared driveway lot, to Na Hale O Maui to allow the property to remain in the workforce housing inventory in perpetuity.
