NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, on Friday, November 16, 2018, beginning at 5:00 p.m., or soon thereafter, at the Kaunakakai Elementary School Cafeteria, Kaunakakai, Molokai, Hawaii, for the purpose of receiving testimony on a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.80B.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ADOPT THE UPDATED MOLOKA'I ISLAND COMMUNITY PLAN."

The purpose of the bill is to adopt a revised Moloka'i Community Plan, also known as the Moloka'i Island Community Plan, including decennial revisions required by Chapter 2.80B, Maui County Code.

Copies of the bill are on file in the Office of the County Clerk, 7th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui and the Molokai Council District Office, 100 Ainoa Street, Kaunakakai, Molokai, for use and examination by the public during regular business hours. The bill is also available on-line at www.mauicounty.gov/MolokaiCommunityPlan.

Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for up to three minutes. If approved by the presiding officer and announced prior to any oral testimony being taken, the testifier may be allowed one minute to conclude their testimony. No further oral testimony by the testifier shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify may be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.

To ensure its distribution prior to the public hearing, written testimony must be received, emailed (county.clerk@mauicounty.us), or faxed (808-270-7171) to the Office of the County Clerk at least 24 hours prior to the public hearing. If written testimony is submitted at the public hearing, 15 copies are requested.

Individuals who intend to attend the public hearing and who have disabilities requiring special assistance should call the Office of the County Clerk at 270-7748, at least three days in advance.
