ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY

No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify may be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.

If the connection between the meeting site in the Council Chamber and any of the remote testimony sites is lost, the meeting in the Council Chamber will still continue.
