CHANGE IN ZONING FOR 266 DICKENSON STREET APARTMENTS (LAHAINA) (PSLU-19)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 18-351, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE ZONING FROM D-2 DUPLEX AND R-2 RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO A-2 APARTMENT DISTRICT FOR PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEYS (2) 4-6-011:011 AND (2) 4-6-011:028, LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF HONOAPIILANI HIGHWAY AND 266 DICKENSON STREET, LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII." The purpose of the proposed bill is to grant a request from Christopher Ondatje for a Change in Zoning from D-2 Two-Family District and R-2 Residential District to A-2 Apartment District for certain parcels of land situated at Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii, collectively comprising 10,597 square feet, and identified for real property tax purposes as tax map keys (2) 4-6-011:011 and (2) 4-6-011:028, to facilitate the development of an eight-unit apartment building.

Status: The Committee will view the property and surrounding area. No legislative action will be taken.
