COUNTY PROPERTY TAX REFORM (EDB-37)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. Miscellaneous Communication dated May 21, 2019, from the County Clerk, referring the matter relating to tax reform, including the possibility of forming a temporary investigative group to investigate the matter pursuant to Section 92-2.5(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
2. Correspondence dated September 27, 2019, from the Committee Chair, transmitting proposed bills to further principles of County property tax reform.
3. Correspondence dated October 11, 2019, from the Committee Chair, transmitting the following:
 - a. A revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TIERS OF REAL PROPERTY TAX RATES." The purpose of the proposed bill is to further principles of County property tax reform, including through the establishment of tiers of real property tax rates. Tiers are established for the following real property classifications: owner-occupied, non-owner-occupied, short-term rental, and commercial/industrial.
 - b. A revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY TAX VALUATIONS." The purpose of the proposed bill is to further principles of County property tax reform, including through the establishment of new real property classifications. The classifications are as follows: owner-occupied, non-owner-occupied, apartment, hotel and resort,

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time share, short-term rental, agricultural, conservation, commercial/industrial, and commercialized residential.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bills on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of the Miscellaneous Communication and other related action.
