a. Accelerated TIP Amendment Policy

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Congress is considering legislation to provide stimulus funds for surface transportation infrastructure. To facilitate the timely addition of state or county projects to receive federal stimulus funds to the Maui TIP, the MPO will consider adopting an accelerated TIP amendment schedule to coordinate with the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Requested action: Recommend that Policy Board adopt Accelerated TIP Amendment Policy, with amendments, deletions or additions as TAC may consider necessary. Take any such additional actions that TAC may consider appropriate.

b. Planning studies update

Update on current and future planning studies being conducted by various County and State departments, as well as Maui MPO.
