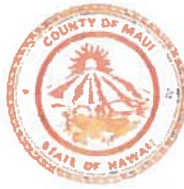



A. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Public Works Commission was called to order by Vice Chairperson Derek Ono at approximately 1:48 p.m., Wednesday, June 20, 2022, via a BlueJeans online video conference, Meeting ID 863 836 953.

A quorum of the Commission was present. (See Record of Attendance.)

B. ACCEPTANCE OF MEETING MINUTES

The Commission unanimously approved acceptance of the April 27, 2022.

C. PUBLIC TESTIMONY

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. Facility Renaming Application to rename Puamana Park, in Lahaina, Maui, TMK: (2) 4-6-033:001, to Waiahiokole Burial Preserve.

Department noted the application is to rename an existing County Park. The Director of Parks and Recreation expressed support for the renaming by correspondence dated May 17, 2022. Renaming applications require review by both the Public Works Commission and the Cultural Resources Commission.

Commission Kawa'a requested the applicant to explain how the proposed name was derived.

The applicant, Keaumoku Kapu, noted the proposed name is a traditional place name for the area near the park and translates to mean the "waters of Hiokole". Hiokole is believed to be a chief of the area. The name was derived through research conducted of native testimony which identified a burial preserve existed at the park's location.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kawa'a and seconded by Commissioner Silva to recommend approval to rename Puamana Park to Waiahiokole Burial Preserve.

The Commission voted 6-0 in favor of the motion.

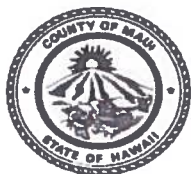

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are required to submit **twelve (12) copies of the typed application and supporting documents** to the Department of Public Works, Engineering Division. The following supporting documents must be attached to the application:

1. Completed Street Name Listing provided on the next page of application. Applicants shall indicate the Street Ownership as either public or private and shall indicate whether private streets are intent to remain private or be dedicated to the County of Maui.
2. Subdivision plat or site plan showing the layout of streets being named or renamed relative to existing or future roadways and subdivision lots. Plat shall be 8-1/2" x 11" in size, to scale, legible, and dated, and shall show street numbers and proposed street names as identified on the application's Street Name Listing.
3. Explanation of the significance of the proposed names and, if applicable, the purpose for renaming the streets.

STANDARDS FOR STREET NAMING AND RENAMING (SECTION 2.98.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE)

Streets shall be named in the Hawaiian Language with appropriate diacritical marks and whenever possible have a meaning that relates to the area's historic significance or follows a uniform theme (i.e. fish, flowers, people, etc.). The reference text for Hawaiian language, place names, and persons shall be the most recent edition of the Hawaiian Dictionary by Pukui/Elbert, and Ulukau, the Hawaii Electronic Library, available online at ulukau.org.

Using a street name more than once on any island shall be avoided as much as practical. Private street names shall not closely resemble existing public streets. Existing streets shall retain the name which has been historically accepted through common usage unless the street is renamed by the Maui County Council.

The Public Works Commission shall review applications for naming new public and private streets and provide its recommendations to the Director of Public Works for approval or denial.

The Public Works Commission and the Cultural Resources Commission shall review applications for renaming existing public or private streets and provide recommendations to the Maui County Council. The Council may adopt, modify, or reject the recommendations. Approval of a street name shall be by resolution.
