**D. NEW BUSINESS**

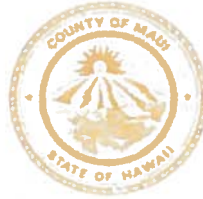

The Department of Public Works is transmitting for your review and recommendation, a revised street naming application for the subject subdivision's roadways. Upon initial review, all the proposed and alternate street names provided may be considered.

Please note that the Commission previously approved the proposed street names Pōhākea Street and Kealoha Avenue at its meeting on April 27, 2022 and expressed no objection to the alternate street names Alahele Drive, Kamaluhia Lane, and 'Ulī'ulī Road.

The revised application includes two (2) new proposed street names, Pulelehua Hale Road and Moana 'Ikena Road, and one (1) revised proposed street name Koholāhula Drive which was revised in response to the Commission's comments on the original application. The revised application also contains two (2) new alternate street names Waioha Drive and Hau'olī'olī Road.

Applicants are required to submit twelve (12) copies of the typed application and supporting documents to the Department of Public Works, Engineering Division. The following supporting documents must be attached to the application:

1. Completed Street Name Listing provided on the next page of application. Applicants shall indicate the Street Ownership as either public or private and shall indicate whether private streets are intent to remain private or be dedicated to the County of Maui.
2. Subdivision plat or site plan showing the layout of streets being named or renamed relative to existing or future roadways and subdivision lots. Plat shall be 8-1/2" x 11" in size, to scale, legible, and dated, and shall show street numbers and proposed street names as identified on the application's Street Name Listing.
3. Explanation of the significance of the proposed names and, if applicable, the purpose for renaming the streets.

### STANDARDS FOR STREET NAMING AND RENAMING (SECTION 2.98.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE)

Streets shall be named in the Hawaiian Language with appropriate diacritical marks and whenever possible have a meaning that relates to the area's historic significance or follows a uniform theme (i.e. fish, flowers, people, etc.). The reference text for Hawaiian language, place names, and persons shall be the most recent edition of the Hawaiian Dictionary by Pukui/Elbert, and Ulukau, the Hawaii Electronic Library, available online at [ulukau.org](http://ulukau.org).

Using a street name more than once on any island shall be avoided as much as practical. Private street names shall not closely resemble existing public streets. Existing streets shall retain the name which has been historically accepted through common usage unless the street is renamed by the Maui County Council.

The Public Works Commission shall review applications for naming new public and private streets and provide its recommendations to the Director of Public Works for approval or denial.

The Public Works Commission and the Cultural Resources Commission shall review applications for renaming existing public or private streets and provide recommendations to the Maui County Council. The Council may adopt, modify, or reject the recommendations. Approval of a street name shall be by resolution.

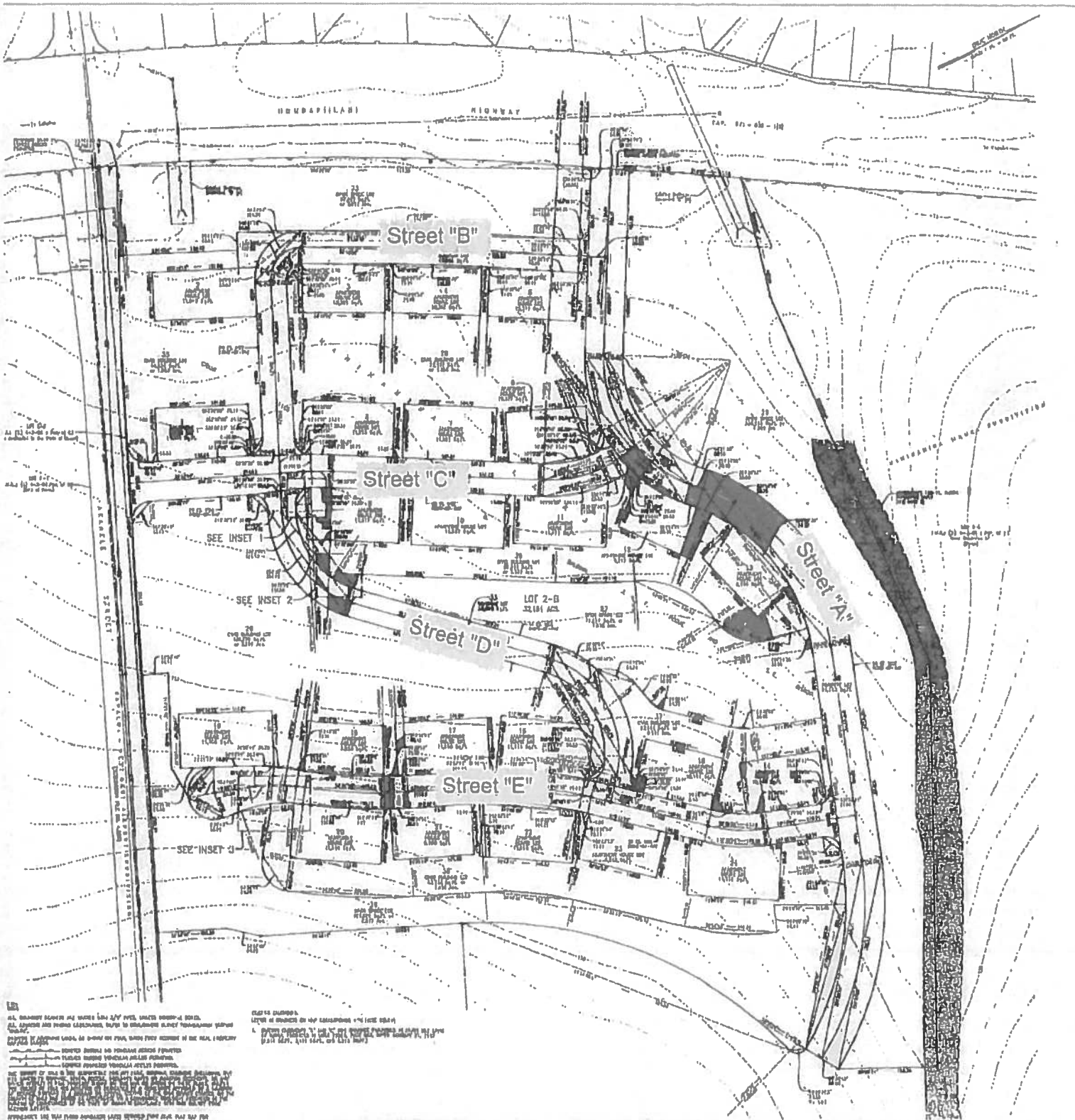

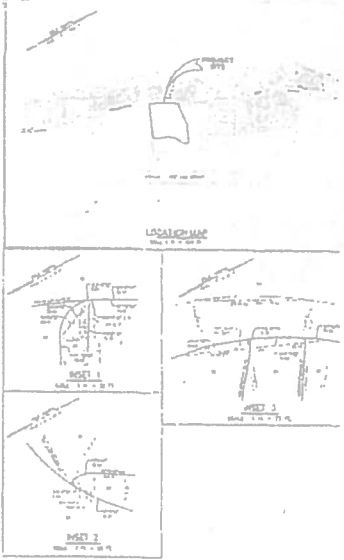

Your application has not been approved. The Public Works Commission at its meeting of April 27, 2022 voted unanimously to recommend approval of the street names Pōhākea Street, Kealoaha Avenue, and 'Ulī'ulī Road and to recommend disapproval of the proposed names Pulelehua Drive, Hulakohola Drive, Alani Street, Pu'uani Street, and Kekalohe Road for the reasons as follows:


- The Department noted that the proposed names Pulelehua Drive and Alani Street and to the alternate name Pu'unani Street are existing street names.
- The Commission's Hawaiian Language Expert noted that the alternate name Hulakohola Drive does not grammatically translate to mean dancing whales as proposed by the applicant. The correct translation for dancing whales is Koholāhula.
- The Commission's Hawaiian Language Expert noted additional information on the proposed translation for the proposed name Kekalohe Road is required to determine whether its spelling and grammar are correct.
- The Commission's Hawaiian Language Expert noted that the alternate name Pu'uani Street does not grammatically translate to mean beautiful hills as proposed by the applicant. The correct translation for beautiful hills is Pu'unani.

Your application indicated that you did not authorize the Commission to amend the proposed names as necessary for approval. Therefore, your application is being returned disapproved. Please review and resubmit your application for reconsideration.

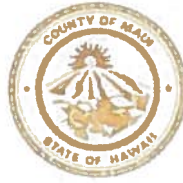

Aloha,

Maui Oceanview LP is writing this letter in regard to our street naming application originally submitted to the department of Public Works on February 25, 2022 by our agent, Tom Coppin, for the Mahinahina Mauka Subdivision – Phase I.

On May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022, we received a letter from the Director of Public Works, Jordan Molina, stating our application has not been approved. After recent phone conversation with Nolly Yagin, we have been instructed to formally send in our response via this letter in order to properly resolve this matter. Tom Coppin, whom the disapproval letter was originally sent to, will also be sending Public Works an electronic version of this letter via email.

We appreciate the time the board has taken in reviewing our application, and acknowledge the comments provided. As relayed in the disapproval letter, it is our understanding that 3 names have been approved so far, and all others have been disapproved for various reasons.

Of the names disapproved, there were 2 names indicated by Public Works to be incorrectly spelled, and the Commission’s Hawaiian Language Expert kindly provided the correct spellings for our review. These include the following:

- *Hulakohola DR* (original) changed to *Koholāhula DR* (corrected) meaning "Dancing Whales"
- *Pu'uani ST* (original) changed to *Pu'unani ST* (corrected) meaning "Beautiful Hills"

Street 2(B): Pu'unani ST → meaning "Beautiful Hills"


Street 3(C): Pōhākea ST → meaning "White Stone, as Limestone"
