Individuals may be disconnected from the meeting for breaking decorum.

Testifiers are asked to mute their audio and video when they are not testifying. Video testifiers will be called first, followed by phone testifiers, and then in-person testifiers.

**In the matter of the accusation against M.S.H. ENTERPRISES, INC. dba CLUB O, located at 1088 Lower Main Street, Room 1, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii; Dispenser General, Categories C(ii) / D, Lic. No. 099.**

Count 1: On January 17, 2023, M.S.H. ENTERPRISES, INC. dba CLUB O, failed to comply with the liquor laws and the rules of the commission, which shall be in effect twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, throughout the year for which the license is issued, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-40(b).

PLEA: FAILED TO SUBMIT A PLEA

**B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2023-06**

**In the matter of the accusation against PASHMINA’S & GIFT INC. dba KAMANA INDIAN CUISINE, located at 1881 S. Kihei Road, B1, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii; Dispenser General, Category C(ii), Lic. No. 467.**

Count 1: On January 23, 2023, PASHMINA’S & GIFT INC. dba KAMANA INDIAN CUISINE, failed to have an on-duty employee duly approved by the director in active charge of each premises during all times that such premises is open for business, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-70(a).

PLEA: NO CONTEST
