TEMPORARY DEVELOPMENT MORATORIUM ON WEST MAUI AGRICULTURAL LAND

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-299, from Councilmember Jo Anne Johnson, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TEMPORARY DEVELOPMENT MORATORIUM ON WEST MAUI AGRICULTURAL LAND". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish a temporary development moratorium on West Maui agricultural land until the West Maui Community Plan is updated and the West Maui traffic impact fees are implemented.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 07-299 and other related action.
