PARKING STANDARDS FOR RESIDENTIAL MIXED USE DEVELOPMENTS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 06-250, from the Council Chair, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO GENERAL PROVISIONS AND DEFINITIONS, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 19.36, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish new parking standards for residential mixed use developments.

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2. Correspondence dated August 31, 2007, from the Council Chair, transmitting correspondence dated August 29, 2007, from the Planning Director, transmitting comments on the draft bill from the Lanai, Maui, and Molokai Planning Commissions, in response to Resolution No. 06-131, entitled "REFERRING A DRAFT BILL PERTAINING TO OFF-STREET PARKING TO THE LANAI, MAUI, AND MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSIONS", adopted on December 1, 2006.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 06-250 and other related action.

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
