WATER SUPPLY RULES

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-46, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, relating to Water Supply Rules.
2. Correspondence dated October 11, 2006, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 14, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PUBLIC SERVICES". The purpose of the draft bill is to codify rules and regulations of the Department of Water Supply.
3. Correspondence dated June 29, 2007, from Council Chair G. Riki Hokama, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO DROUGHT DECLARATIONS". The purpose of the draft bill is to codify Department of Water Supply drought regulations.
4. Correspondence dated August 1, 2007, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a document entitled "MAUI DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY UPCOUNTRY DROUGHT PLAN GUIDELINES".

WATER CONSERVATION

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-273, from Councilmember Dain P. Kane, relating to water conservation.
2. County Communication No. 06-166, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, transmitting a copy of a computer-generated slideshow entitled "Working Together to Conserve Precious Water Through Innovation".
3. County Communication No. 07-40, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting the Board of Water Supply's proposed elements of a water conservation plan, pursuant to Chapter 14.03, Maui County Code.
4. Correspondence dated July 15, 2008, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN OUTDOOR IRRIGATION AND WATER USE SCHEDULE". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish a watering schedule for irrigation and personal car washing.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to seek the advice of the Board of Water Supply on the draft bill, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions, and other related action.
