**In the matter of the accusation against KALA MART INC. dba KALA MART, Retail General License No. 232, 2511 South Kihei Road, #104-A, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On June 28, 2007 at approximately 6:26 p.m., KALA MART INC. dba KALA MART, a retail general licensee, did, through its employee, sell or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2008-09, PLEA: GUILTY**

**In the matter of the accusation against SS3 L.L.C. dba BLACKIE'S PIT STOP, Retail General License No. 339, 70 Kapunakea Street, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On June 29, 2007 at approximately 8:30 p.m., SS3 L.L.C. dba BLACKIE'S PIT STOP, a retail general licensee, did, through its employee, sell or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2008-10, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against CAL-HI-ASPEN CORP. dba FIVE PALMS BEACH GRILL, Dispenser General License No. 149, 2960 South Kihei Road, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.**

- Count 1. On July 21, 2007 at approximately 8:28 p.m., CAL-HI-ASPEN CORP. dba FIVE PALMS BEACH GRILL, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
