On February 13, 2004 between the approximate times of 10:45 a.m. and 1:10 p.m., 3090 INCORPORATED dba ALII NUI CHARTERS, a tour or cruise vessel licensee, did, through their employee(s), fail to exercise due care as defined in Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, in determining whether Carolann Sabatino was under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 08-101-60(b)(11) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- B. <u>COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2006-33, PLEA: NO CONTEST</u>
 In the matter of the accusation against MCBARNET PAIA CORPORATION dba PAIA CHEVRON, Retail Beer and Wine License No. 402, 99 Hana Highway, Paia, Maui, Hawaii.

On July 16, 2005 at approximately 7:20 p.m., MCBARNET PAIA CORPORATION dba PAIA CHEVRON, a retail beer and wine licensee, did, through its employee, sell or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

 In the matter of the accusation against KING & MARTIN, INC. dba
 HECOCKS ON THE OCEAN, Dispenser General License No. 022, 505 Front
 Street, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.
 - Count 1. On June 26, 2005 at approximately 2:21 a.m., KING & MARTIN, INC. dba HECOCKS ON THE OCEAN, a dispenser general licensee, did, have the sale, service, or consumption of liquor on or within its licensed premises before or after the hours prescribed by the commission, contrary to Section 08-101-25(c) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
 - Count 2. On June 26, 2005 at approximately 2:21 a.m., KING & MARTIN, INC. dba HECOCKS ON THE OCEAN, a dispenser general licensee, failed to exercise due care to ensure that no person or employee, while on duty, be permitted to consume any alcoholic beverages, contrary to Section 08-101-80(a)(1) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
 - Count 3. On June 26, 2005 at approximately 2:21 a.m., KING & MARTIN, INC. dba HECOCKS ON THE OCEAN, a dispenser general licensee, failed to maintain time record entries at the time the employee reports on duty and again when the employee goes off duty, contrary to Section 08-101-70(f) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
