WR-13 PROHIBITING DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS WITHOUT A

LONG-TERM RELIABLE SOURCE OF WATER

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-271, from Councilmember Dain P. Kane, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.04.020, MAUI

- COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO GENERAL PROVISIONS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit subdivisions without a long-term, reliable source of water.
- 2. Correspondence dated August 29, 2007, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14.01, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIAN WATER RIGHTS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the County Water Code to exempt rights and entitlements to water provided for by the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, from the County Water Code.
- 3. Correspondence dated October 9, 2007, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 14, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND TITLE 18, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WATER AVAILABILITY". The purpose of the draft bill is to verify the availability of a long-term, reliable source of water of at least 20 years prior to subdivision approval.
- 4. Correspondence dated October 9, 2007, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, transmitting a draft resolution entitled "REFERRING A DRAFT BILL RELATING TO WATER AVAILABILITY TO THE LANAI, MAUI, AND MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSIONS AND THE BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY". The purpose of the draft resolution is to transmit a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 14, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WATER AVAILABILITY" to the planning commissions, pursuant to Charter Sections 8-8.4 and 8-8.6, and to the Board of Water Supply. The purpose of the draft bill is to verify the availability of a long-term reliable source of water of at least 20 years prior to any land entitlements.

**STATUS:** 

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill transmitted by the Department of the Corporation Counsel on August 29, 2007 on first reading, passage of the draft bill transmitted by Councilmember Anderson on October 9, 2007 on first reading, and adoption of the draft resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 05-271 and other related action.

  the draft bill is to codify Department of Water Supply drought regulations.

The Committee may also consider regulations regarding drought declarations and water rates and fees. The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bills on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 05-46 and other related action.
