A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2005-33, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against SLY MONGOOSE, INC. dba SLY MONGOOSE, Dispenser General License No. 275, 1036 Limahana Place, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On January 25, 2005 and January 26, 2005 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:25 a.m., SLY MONGOOSE, INC. dba SLY MONGOOSE, a dispenser general licensee, did, through their employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Jeremiah Michael McDougall, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, drugs, as defined in Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, or any combination thereof, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2006-06, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against CASANOVA, INC. dba CASANOVA, Restaurant General License No. 387, 1188 Makawao Avenue, Makawao, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On May 25, 2005 and May 26, 2005 between the approximate times of 10:00 p.m. and 1:30 a.m., CASANOVA, INC. dba CASANOVA, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by one, Dennett M. K. Hesla, who was a minor as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes

and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2006-09, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against CASANOVA, INC. dba CASANOVA, Restaurant General License No. 387, 1188 Makawao Avenue, Makawao, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On June 2, 2005 at approximately 12:49 a.m., CASANOVA, INC. dba CASANOVA, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by one, Joanna Marie F. Milla, who was a minor as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
