CLOSURE OF KANAHA BEACH PARK CAMPGROUND

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 08-109, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, in accordance with Section 13.04.060 of the Maui County Code, informing of the closure of Kanaha Beach Park campground, located at Amala Place in Kahului, from April 16, 2008 through June 3, 2008, to conduct major maintenance activities.

STATUS:

PROHIBITING PARKING ON AMALA PLACE (KAHULUI)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-235, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING". The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit parking on both sides of Amala Place, Kahului, Maui, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

PWF-72 PROHIBITION OF DRINKING NEAR PLAYGROUND AREAS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 08-76, from Councilmember Michael P. Victorino, transmitting a draft bill, amending Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code, to prohibit drinking in parks containing playgrounds or in close proximity to a playground during specified time periods.
2. Correspondence dated May 28, 2008, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO RECREATIONAL AREA REGULATIONS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code, to prohibit drinking in parks containing playgrounds or in close proximity to a playground during specified time periods.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 08-76 and other related action.

PWF-74 DESIGNATION OF IAO INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL LOADING ZONE

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 08-83, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.56A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO LOADING ZONES". The purpose of the proposed bill is to designate thirteen stalls on South Market Street, fronting Iao Intermediate School, as a loading zone from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on school days.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 08-83 and other related action.
