### REQUIRING WIDER SIDEWALKS

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-194, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill to require five-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the street in all areas zoned residential or duplex, or in the County's interim zone.
2. Public Works Committee Report No. 05-131 (Recommitted), recommending passage of a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.20.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SIDEWALKS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to require new developments to install five-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the street in all areas zoned residential or duplex, or in the County's interim zone.

**STATUS:** The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 05-194 and Committee Report No. 05-131, and other related action.

**DESCRIPTION:**    The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-272, from the Economic Development Coordinator, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND DESIGNATION OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS A ‘PRESERVE AMERICA COMMUNITY’”. **PWF-55                    WAIVING CERTAIN PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PINEAPPLE HILL AT KAPALUA PHASE II SUBDIVISION (LAHAINA)**

**DESCRIPTION:**    The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-274, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “WAIVER OF COMFORT STATION AND PARKING AREA REQUIREMENTS IN THE PINEAPPLE HILL AT KAPALUA PHASE II SUBDIVISION, LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII, PURSUANT TO SECTION 18.16.320, MAUI COUNTY CODE”. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve the waiver of requirements to provide comfort stations and parking areas in a privately owned and maintained linear park running from Lower Honoapiilani Road to Honoapiilani Highway in the Pineapple Hill at Kapalua Phase II Subdivision, Lahaina, Maui, consisting of approximately 33,905 square feet, TMK: (2) 4-3-01:005.

**DESCRIPTION:**    The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-119, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled “APPROVING THE WAIVER OF CERTAIN PARK REQUIREMENTS FOR A PRIVATELY OWNED AND MAINTAINED PARK PURSUANT TO SECTION 18.16.320, MAUI COUNTY CODE, FOR THE KIHEI KAUAHALE SUBDIVISION, KIHEI, MAUI, HAWAII”. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve the waiver of requirements to provide comfort stations and a parking area in a privately owned and maintained park located adjacent to Waipuilani Road in the Kihei Kauhale Subdivision, Kihei, Maui, consisting of approximately 10,501 square feet, TMK: (2) 3-9-46:014.
