AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO RECREATIONAL AREA REGULATIONS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 08-269, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO RECREATIONAL AREA REGULATIONS". The purposes of the proposed bill are to: (1) authorize certain individuals, including Park Security Officers, to issue citations for violations of Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code; and (2) clarify the penalties for such violations.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 08-269 and other related action.

PWF-83 AMENDING CHAPTER 18.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SUBDIVISION GENERAL PROVISIONS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:
1. County Communication No. 08-155, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill to amend various sections of Chapter 18.04, Maui County Code, pertaining to subdivision general provisions.
2. Correspondence dated October 3, 2008, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SUBDIVISION GENERAL PROVISIONS". The purposes of the revised proposed bill are to: (1) limit lot line adjustments to two lots; (2) clarify differences between a condominium lot and a subdivision lot; (3) update the Maui County Code with the correct name of the department; and (4) allow the director to recognize a separate lot in certain instances.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 08-155 and other related action.

PWF-98 AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSING OF COUNTY OF MAUI REAL PROPERTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE LAHAINA BYPASS FEDERAL AID PROJECT NO. NH-030-1(35)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 08-272, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSING OF COUNTY OF MAUI REAL PROPERTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE LAHAINA BYPASS, FEDERAL AID PROJECT NO. NH-030-1(35), AT LAHAINA, MAUI". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize transfer, by Quitclaim Deed, of the remaining County-owned parcels from Subdivision File No. 4.962, situated at Kelaweia, Lahaina [TMK: (2) 4-5-31:(Portion of Road), described as Lots 261, 262, and 45, and Boundary "15" and "20"; and TMK: (2) 4-5-34:Portions of Lahainaluna Road, Liloa Street, North Hakau Place, and South Hakau Place, described as Portion of Lot 47, Portion of MRS-2, Portions of Lots 259, 260, and 263 together with Abutter's Rights of Vehicle Access] to the, Department of Transportation, State of Hawaii, for purposes of constructing the Lahaina Bypass.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 08-272 and other related action.

PWF-72 PROHIBITION OF DRINKING NEAR PLAYGROUND AREAS

Mar. 7/08 C.C. 08-76 Councilmember Victorino, transmitting a draft bill, entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PROHIBITIONS IN PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES”, to amend Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code, to prohibit drinking in parks containing playgrounds or in close proximity to a playground during specified time periods.

PWF-74 DESIGNATION OF IAO INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL LOADING ZONE

Sep. 5/08 C.C. 08-203 Director of Public Works, returning Public Works and Facilities Committee Report No.08-70, recommending passage of a proposed bill, entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.56A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO LOADING ZONES”, to designate 13 stalls on the makai side of South Market Street, fronting Iao Intermediate School, as a loading zone from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on school days.
