NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, on Tuesday, May 22, 2007, beginning at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, in the Council Chamber, 8th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii, for the purpose of receiving testimony on the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2007 TO JUNE 30, 2008".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to appropriate estimated revenues for the operating and capital improvement budget. Incorporated within the proposed bill are Appendix A, which lists Grant Revenues and Special Purpose Revenues, and Appendix B, which is the Schedule of Rates, Fees, and Assessments.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CAPITAL PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2008".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to set forth the Capital Program for FY 2008 through 2013. Appendix A is a list of all pending capital improvement projects and appropriations as of December 31, 2006, and Appendix B is the proposed Capital Program for FY 2008 through 2013.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THIRTY SEVEN MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$37,050,000) AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO PAY ALL OR A PART OF THE COST OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS OF AND FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI; FIXING THE FORM, DENOMINATIONS AND CERTAIN OTHER FEATURES OF SUCH BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR SALE; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO DETERMINE CERTAIN DETAILS OF THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF A LIKE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT

OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SUCH BONDS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER ACTIONS RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds for various capital improvement projects.

4. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT PART OF THE PROCEEDS OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI HERETOFORE ISSUED IS IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNTS REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH BONDS WERE INITIALLY ISSUED, OR MAY OR SHOULD NOT BE APPLIED TO THOSE PURPOSES, AND DIRECTING SUCH PROCEEDS TO OTHER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS OR AUTHORIZED PURPOSES OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to reauthorize the use of lapsed bond proceeds for various capital improvement projects.

5. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR DEPLOYED ACTIVE-DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a real property tax exemption for deployed active-duty military personnel.

6. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.08.060, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SALARIES OF PERSONNEL IN THE OFFICE OF COUNCIL SERVICES AND OTHER COUNCIL STAFF".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the salaries of positions in the Office of Council Services.

7. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SALARIES OF DEPUTIES CORPORATION COUNSEL AND DEPUTIES PROSECUTING ATTORNEY".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the salaries of deputies in the Department of the Corporation Counsel and the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney.

8. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13.16, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WAIEHU MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to add definitions for "Daily rate" and "Twilight rate" and revise the definition of "Playing fee" for the Waiehu Municipal Golf Course.

9. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.16.080, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO REDEMPTION OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the charges to capture, impound, and keep an animal and all pound fees to be set forth in the annual budget.

10. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.20A.130, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE PLUMBING CODE".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to correct a conflict pertaining to the fee for a new plumbing permit following expiration of a permit.

11. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.30.020, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE FIRST-TIME HOME BUYERS' REVOLVING FUND".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to repeal the provision that states that any balance in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse.

12. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH A POST-EMPLOYMENT OBLIGATIONS FUND".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a post-employment obligations fund for the purpose of funding the County's financial liabilities for post-employment benefits accrued under the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Hawaii and the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund.

13. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.20A.200, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO MISCELLANEOUS PLUMBING INSTALLATION INSPECTIONS".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the amount of the miscellaneous plumbing installation inspection fee to be set forth in the annual budget.

14. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.20.250, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SUBDIVISION INSPECTION FEES".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the amount of the fee for inspecting construction improvements on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays to be set forth in the annual budget.

15. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.68.060, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO VOTER REGISTRATION COMPUTER TAPES".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the rental charge and deposit amount for the use of voter registration computer tapes to be set forth in the annual budget.

16. A proposed resolution entitled "ADOPTING THE FUEL TAX RATES FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007".

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to adopt fuel tax rates in accordance with Section 243-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and Section 3.20.010, Maui County Code.

Copies of the proposed bills and resolution are on file in the Office of the County Clerk, 7th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii, for use and examination by the public during regular business hours.

The Council shall receive testimony first from persons whose testimony forms are submitted prior to the convening of the public hearing. Initially, three (3) minutes will be granted, and at the discretion of the Council Chair, an additional minute may be granted to conclude the testimony; or an additional three (3) minutes will be granted to those who are unable to conclude their testimony, after all others desiring to speak have been heard.

Thereafter, persons whose testimony forms are submitted after the public hearing convenes will be allowed to present oral testimony for three (3) minutes. The Chair may grant an additional minute to conclude the testimony.

Written testimony must be submitted, e-mailed (county.clerk@mauicounty.us), or faxed (808-270-7171) to the Office of the County Clerk 24 hours prior to the public hearing so copies can be provided to the Council Members. If written testimony is submitted at the public hearing, 15 copies are requested.
