CLARIFYING TERMS OF APPOINTMENTS TO KULA AGRICULTURAL PARK COMMITTEE

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-222, from Councilmember Mateo, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 22.04A.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE KULA AGRICULTURAL PARK COMMITTEE". The purpose of the proposed bill is to clarify the terms of appointments for the Council's and Mayor's representatives to the Kula Agricultural Park Committee.

POL-33 FIRST TIME HOME BUYERS' PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 07-234, from Councilmember Molina, relating to the matter of the First Time Home Buyers' Program, and attaching the following:

POL-8(2) AMENDMENTS TO THE RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY (VARIOUS)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated February 5, 2007, from the Council Chair, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE THE COUNTY FEES REQUIRED FOR RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING UNITS". The purpose of the draft bill is to amend various sections of the Maui County Code to decrease the County fees required to build residential workforce housing units.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action.
